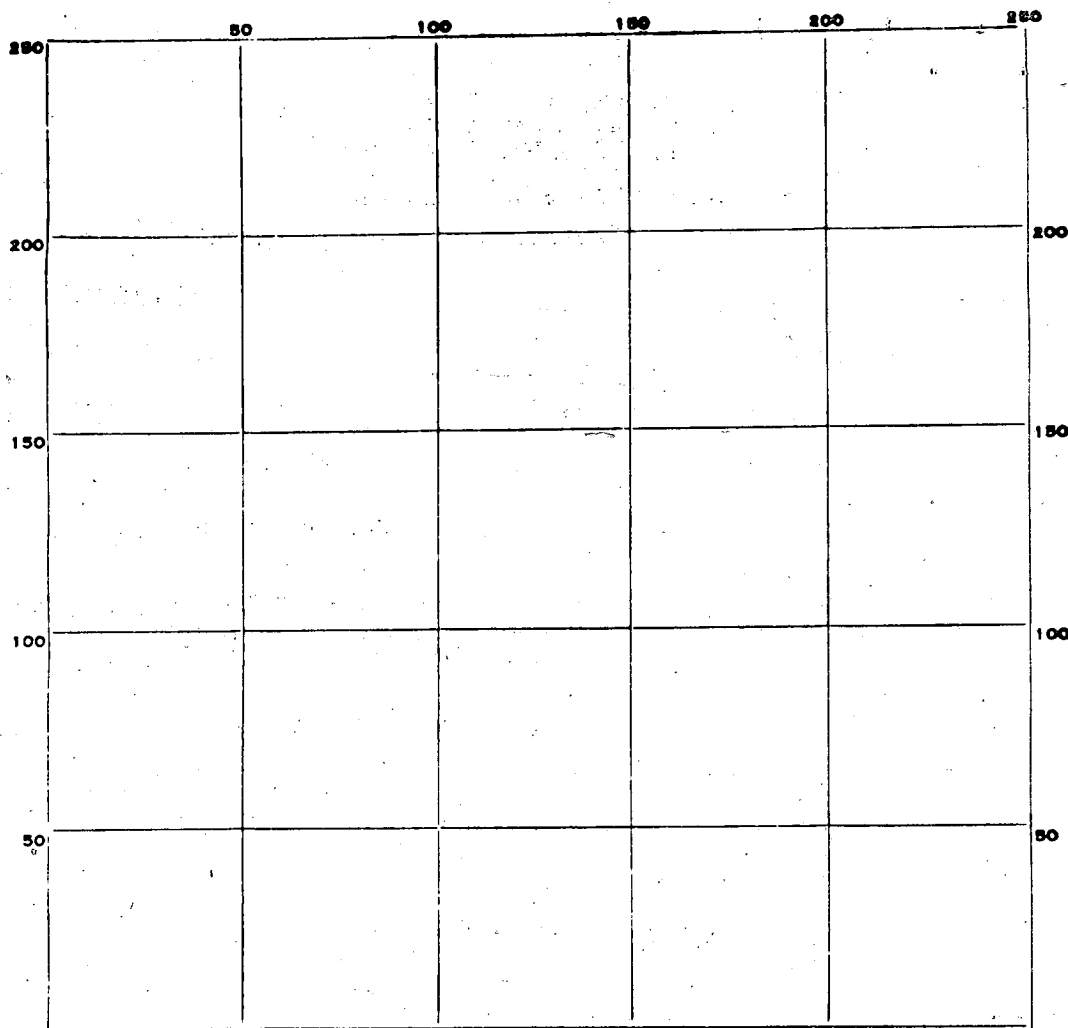

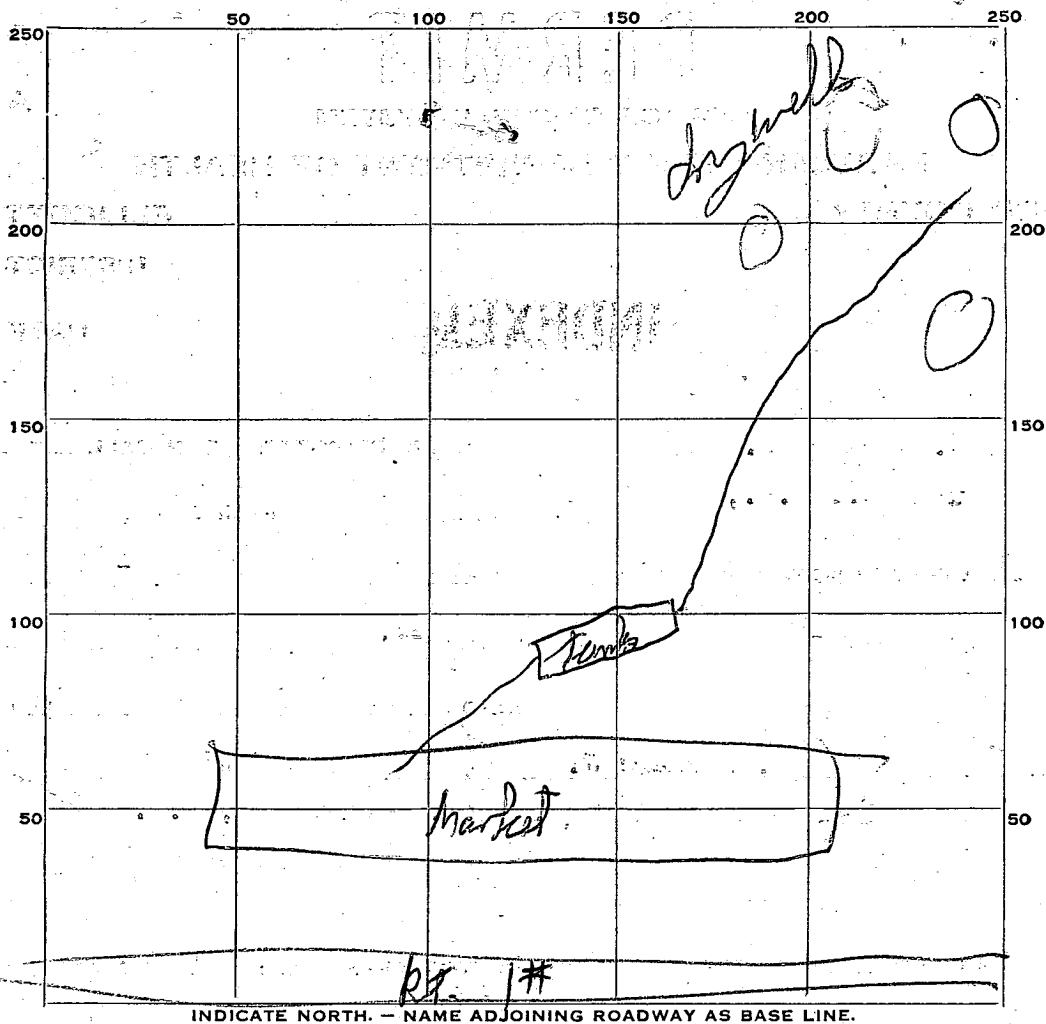

Dear Mr. Howison:

On November 23, 1959 application was made at this office for percolation tests for a proposed Farmer's Market located in the First Election District on the Washington Boulevard near Waterloo.

On December 1, 1959 after extensive tests were conducted a small area of land was found that was suitable for underground sewage disposal. Mr. W. B. Hallett was present and signed the percolation test results at that time. A copy of the application was approved and given to your representative on the basis of not more than 100 employees would use the facilities at the Farmer's Market.

Recently, word has come to this office that a restaurant, beauty parlor, etc., might be located in the building now under construction. I think you should understand at this time that the approval granted you on December 1, 1959 did not include restaurants or any type of business that would use more than a nominal amount of water. Our approval was granted with the understanding that employees of the proposed Farmer's Market would be the only ones using the sewage facilities.

In light of the above facts we <sup>only</sup> cannot grant approval as ~~originally~~ stipulated on the original application.
