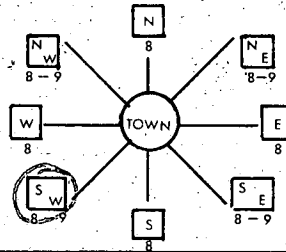

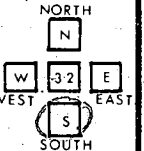
DIRECTION OF WELL FROM TOWN (CIRCLE BOX)

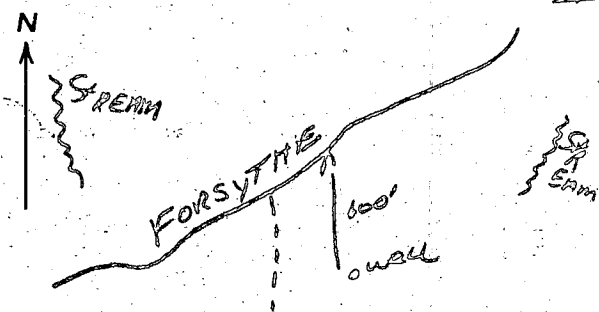
