



Dear Mr. Nixon:

We conducted a site evaluation of the referenced property with your staff, Mike Davis and Jeff Williams, on April 18, 2012. This was a re-evaluation of a previously approved sand mound sewage disposal area that subsequent to its approval had substantial stockpiles of fill placed on it, and soil compaction resulting from filling. These conditions rendered the lot unsuitable for the installation of the sand mound sewage disposal system for which it had been approved. Our evaluation was to determine if there were any non conventional on-site sewage disposal systems that could be designed and approved that would be adequate to serve a proposed house.

From the soils described and the percolation tests performed on April 18th, (see attached) it does not appear possible for an on-site sewage disposal system to be designed to properly function on this site. The site is currently configured with compacted soil underlying fill of varying depths that are not incorporated into the existing soils.



#### MEMO TO FILE

At the request of Tom Ashton, I accompanied him on a site visit to Highland Acres, Lot 12 (tax ID: 05-353033) on July 26, 2012 on our way to another site in Carroll County.

It was observed that a majority of the fill piles that were present on my last site visit of April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2012 over a portion of the previously approved sand mound areas had been removed by a machine. The uncontrolled removal of this material, which was not authorized by Tom Ashton, the HCHD or MDE appears to have been done in a haphazard manner with little regard to the sensitive nature of this site and the existing soil and site conditions. Excavation below what appears to have been the former existing filled grade was noticed in one area where ponded surface water was accumulating.

Tom made his assessment of the situation and assisted me in temporarily staking the locations of the test pits that were excavated on April 18, 2012 so that I could take pictures of the new disturbance with these stakes as a reference point. Several pictures of this new disturbance were taken.



We conducted a site evaluation of the referenced property with your staff, Mike Davis and Jeff Williams, on April 18, 2012. This was a re-evaluation of a previously approved sand mound sewage disposal area that subsequent to its approval had substantial stockpiles of fill placed on it, and soil compaction resulting from filling. These conditions rendered the lot unsuitable for the installation of the sand mound sewage disposal system for which it had been approved. Our evaluation was to determine if there were any non conventional on-site sewage disposal systems that could be designed and approved that would be adequate to serve a proposed house.

From the soils described and the percolation tests performed on April 18th, (see attached) it does not appear possible for an on-site sewage disposal system to be designed to properly function on this site. The site is currently configured with compacted soil underlying fill of varying depths that are not incorporated into the existing soils.

#### MEMO TO FILE

At the request of Tom Ashton, I accompanied him on a site visit to Highland Acres, Lot 12 (tax ID: 05-353033) on July 26, 2012 on our way to another site in Carroll County.

It was observed that a majority of the fill piles that were present on my last site visit of April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2012 over a portion of the previously approved sand mound areas had been removed by a machine. The uncontrolled removal of this material, which was not authorized by Tom Ashton, the HCHD or MDE appears to have been done in a haphazard manner with little regard to the sensitive nature of this site and the existing soil and site conditions. Excavation below what appears to have been the former existing filled grade was noticed in one area where ponded surface water was accumulating.

Tom made his assessment of the situation and assisted me in temporarily staking the locations of the test pits that were excavated on April 18, 2012 so that I could take pictures of the new disturbance with these stakes as a reference point. Several pictures of this new disturbance were taken.

With mound systems, that can ruin the possibility of installing a system in that area because of soil compaction. We discussed the issue with MDE and we don't yet know what they can do (if anything) to assure us that the area is not compromised to the point of being unusable as septic area. This lot just barely managed to get a system as it was, so if the area is no good, the lot may end up non-buildable.

#### Our comments for this plan are:

Because the septic area has been compromised by the dirt stockpile, the Health Department, in consultation with MDE Onsite Systems Division, must evaluate the property to determine if it is still buildable.





Sorry for the delayed response, but I have been out of the office. As you are aware, MDE and the Howard County Health Department have determined that Highland Acres, lot 12 is not suitable for a conventional or non-conventional on-site sewage disposal system in its current condition. I am not aware of any remediation that would change that determination. It is my professional opinion that allowing a new home to be constructed on a site under these or a future altered condition is a bad idea. However, MDE and the Howard County Health Department did not prohibit the previous owners from pursuing their options with a private consultant. Therefore, I cannot give you a definitive no for pursuing options on behalf of Susquehanna Bank. As you are aware, MDE and the Howard County Health Department have determined that Highland Acres, lot 12 is not suitable for a conventional or non-conventional on-site sewage disposal system in its current condition. I am not aware of any remediation that would change that determination. It is my professional opinion that allowing a new home to be constructed on a site under these or a future altered condition is a bad idea. However, MDE and the Howard County Health Department did not prohibit the previous owners from pursuing their options with a private consultant. Therefore, I cannot give you a definitive no for pursuing options on behalf of Susquehanna Bank. Please be advised that if too much soil below original grade has been removed, no remediation will change the current determination.
