This is to advise that the connection from the house to the street has been installed and inspected for the referenced property. A Community Septic System and a Community Water System serve this dwelling. Final approval was granted on 8/02/2005 by HCHD for the house connection. Maryland Department of the Environment issued a Certificate of Potability on May 19, 2005.

Please refer to the Interim Certificate of Potability from MDE for the water results and disclosures regarding the Wells, as this information must be made available to any purchaser of this property, before entering into a contract of sale or lease.

RECOMMENDATION FOR USE AND OCCUPANCY

This certifies that the **initial** sampling requirements of COMAR 26.04.04.09 "Well Regulations" have been met for the water supply system installed under well permit #HO-94-1310 & #HO-94-1311. Although the submitted sample results are in compliance with COMAR standards, the Health Department does not guarantee water supplies. Based upon satisfactory investigation and evaluation, the Howard County Health Department, as authorized by the Maryland Department of the Environment, Reference #013-005, accepts this well system as required by COMAR 26.04.04.
