This letter is being issued in response to your waiver request. This agency has **approved** the waiver to the required Percolation Certification Plan and perc testing to establish a septic reserve area as required by the *Howard County Code*, *Subtitle 8, Section 3.805*. The waiver has been approved on the basis that the proposed storage building is on a 6 acre property and located on the opposite side of the home approximately 300 feet from the existing on-site sewage disposal system. Any deviations from the site plan submitted with the building permit will be subject to further review by this Department.
