

Percolation testing conducted Thursday, October 15, 1998, on the above referenced property, yielded satisfactory soil conditions. Copies of the percolation test results are enclosed.

The percolation test successfully delineated an area of sufficient size to support a riding arena with discharge not to exceed 400 gallons per day, i.e. a single restroom and a washing machine.

In order to qualify for building permit approval, a Percolation Certification Plan showing the following information should be submitted to this office by a registered engineer:

- actual locations & elevations of all excavated test holes
- suitable house and well site
- locations of existing wells and septice within 100 feet of property boundaries
- streams/swales/springs and any other relevant landscape features contour lines.

and dont let fyock change the test date since they want to go over several issues with you at the site


"they" is two private horseriding instructors for the family, who laugh when I describe them as staff, since they sem to be more of an extended family

This is in regard to the above referenced percolation test application which is to establish septic capacity to support the limited wastewater disposal needs of a private horseriding facility to include a single restroom and washing machine; total discharge not expected to exceed 400 gallons per day.

This office had previously suggested that testing in the proposed location be delayed until the spring wet-season. But upon more detailed discussion with your representatives Keg Berlin and Josh Cardine, we did agree that there was reasonable possibility of a successful outcome on the ridge area without waiting for the wet season. This is to follow-up on previous correspondence about your percolation test application for Parcel B of the Riggs Meadow Subdivision. In a letter dated September 22, we had advised that spring wet-season evaluation would likely be necessary for this site.

Taking a second look at the plan with your representative, Mr. Keg Berline, it is now seen that the proposed test area is located on a minor ridge which shows at least reasonable potential for successful evaluation at a non wet season time.

Accordingly, we have scheduled a test date for 10:00 am on Wednesday October 12, 1998. Your contractor should excavate test holes at appropriate locations immediately prior to our time of arrival. At the conclusion of testing we can also consider well site options and other site issues that may be of concern to you.



This office is in receipt of your percolation test application for Parcel P of the Riggs Meadow Subdivision.

Prior percolation test history in this subdivision in landscape positions similar to the location you have proposed for testing suggests the need for spring wet-season evaluation since seasonal groundwater level is potentially a limiting factor on this site.

As discussed yesterday with Mr. Keg Berline on your behalf, a preview conference is suggested to determine how best to proceed.
