Please submit the paperwork for a refund of \$165 to JET Septic, Inc., who paid \$330 for a repair perc test (\$165) and repair septic permit (\$165) as part of receipt #59897 for 1130 St. Michaels Road

JET paid for the testing and permit, but during a site inspection with the Health Department, they discovered that the system failure was caused by a clogged pipe. No work was performed by the Health Department related to the septic permit, but the site inspection was performed as part of the repair perc fee. Therefore, the \$165 fee for the repair septic permit may be refunded, but the \$165 for the repair perc test will be retained to cover the site inspection.


