This should be submitted within sixty (60) days to allow field verification if necessary.



I have reviewed the file and determined that we will not require a Perc Certification Plan even though our file does not contain a signed Perc Certification Plan. The unsigned plan provides all of the details that would be required on a Perc Certification Plan. We will however need an approved BAT site plan prior to the release of a building permit. I realize that the proposed change to the regulation may in the end result in not requiring the installation of a BAT, however until the regulation changes we need the BAT site plan prior to building permit approval.
