Reference is made to our Greenbridge Road development, S-90-16, the Department of Planning and Zoning review comments of October 5 and our recent meeting with you pertaining to the comments being referred to the Health Department.

Be advised that engineer modifications to the plan have corrected the following items:

- 1. Well installations will be above their respective septic fields.
- 2. Septic field 200' separation distance from the stream has been provided. In addition, we discussed pumping from the house to the septic field. However, we have eliminated this aspect and all proposed units will have gravity feed systems.

Based on your comments at our meeting I believe we have addressed the County Health Department's concerns except for additional septic field tests.

Your interest and discussion of our project at our meeting of November 8th was greatly appreciated. Attached is a print of the revised site plan for your information.

COMMENTS

RE: S-90-16, Greenbridge, Lots 1-5

- / 1. Bill #43, effective September 25, 1989, permits no further major subdivision processing in the western part of Howard County for the next 18 months past the present process of sketch plans.
 - 2. Septic should be located 200 feet from any stream Valley, Lots 4 and 5 do not comply. Contact the Health Department.
 - 3. In accordance with Section 16.116.C.4.(ii), grading or removal of vegetative cover shall not be permitted on existing 25 percent or greater slopes adjacent to wetlands, lot 4 and 5 do not comply.
 - 4. Indicate the required 75 foot wide streambank and 25 foot wide wetlands buffer as per Section 16.116.C.6. of the Howard County Subdivision and Land Development Regulations.
 - 5. The location of Lot 5's well is not in compliance with Section 16.116.C.6.
 - 6. Septic areas are shown on 15-25 percent slopes which are highly erodible, check with the Health Department.
 - 7. Explain why there are existing and proposed septic areas on lots 103.
 - The site is mostly wooded, provide a vegetative analysis for the site.

Show all topo, structures that are within 200 feet from the property lines.
