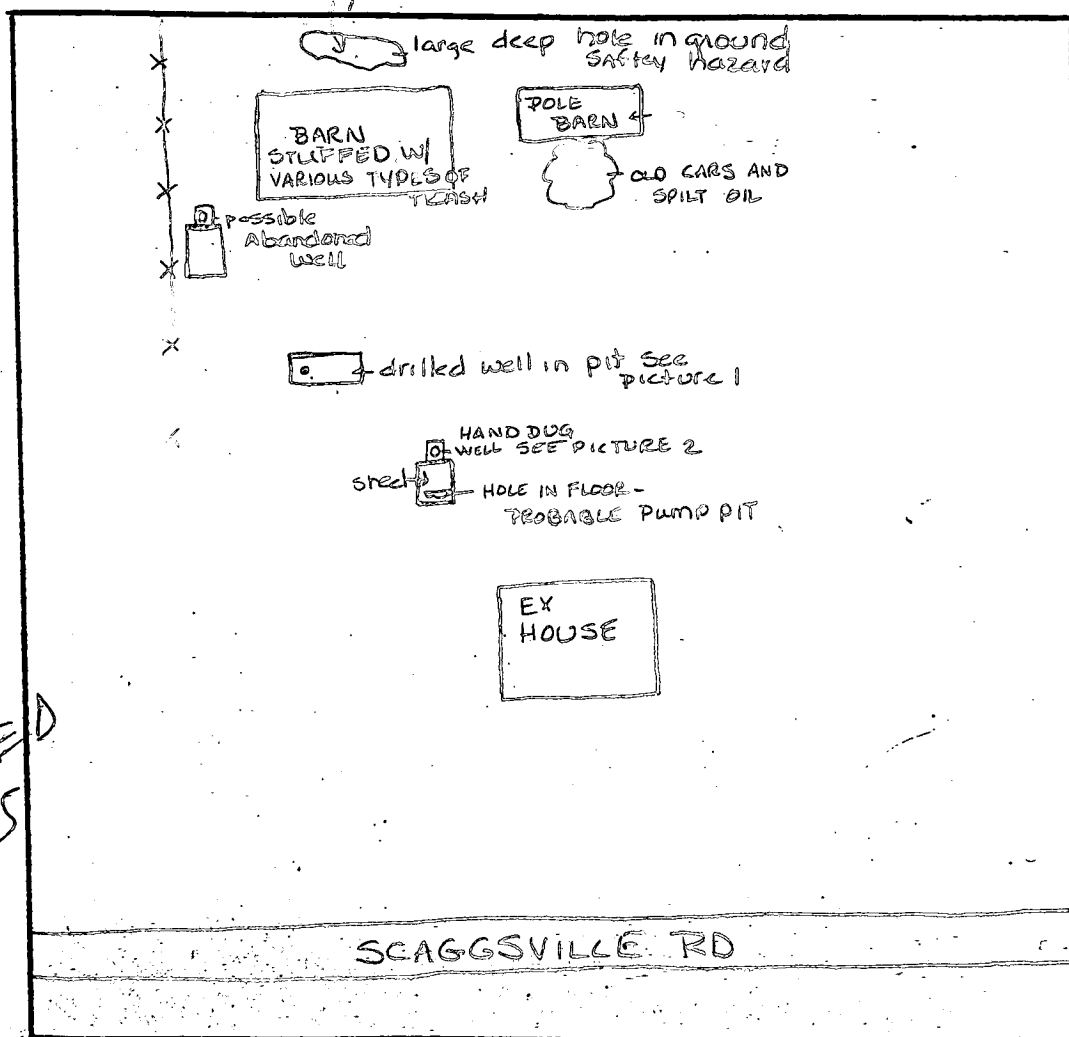

Dear Mr. Collins:

On October 19, 1994, the Howard County Department of Planning and Zoning brought to the attention of Environmental Health several potential environmental concerns at the above listed property. These concerns included an accumulation of trash, and an open hand dug well. The Department of Planning and Zoning (P&Z) was also concerned about a pit behind the barn and spilled oil on the property.

On October 21, 1994, Dale Foxwell of P&Z, Amy McMillen of Environmental Health's Water and Sewerage program, and Justina Taylor of Environmental Health's Community Environmental Health Program, visited the property to assess the problems noted. A hand dug, open well was found, along with a well house in very fragile condition. The present condition of a well of this type is a potential source of groundwater contamination and is a very serious safety matter. This well must be properly abandoned and sealed. This process can be accomplished either by a licensed well driller or under the direct supervision of a Health Department Sanitarian. Failure to address this issue within 15 days of receipt of this letter could result in appropriate enforcement action.

You have 30 days to correct these problems. You need to contact the Howard County Health Department at 410-313-2640 to discuss appropriate steps to remedy these issues.

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
