IV. Pre-Submission Meeting Requirements

HDC Meeting Requirement A pre-submission advisory meeting with the Historic District Commission is required for new development located within a Historic District or if the site is listed in the Historic Sites Inventory in accordance with Section 16.605 of the Howard County Code. The property owner/developer must contact the DPZ, Division of Public Service and Zoning Administration for the HDC scheduling process and procedures. The property owner/developer must submit a copy of the minutes from the HDC Advisory Meeting to DPZ along with the initial subdivision or site development plan application.
- b. MAA Meeting Requirement For all proposed subdivisions or developments located within the BWI Airport Noise Zone or the Airport Zoning District (4 mile radius from the center of the airport), the review and approval by the Maryland Aviation Administration is required prior to signature approval of final plan road and SWM construction drawings, and/or site development plans, or waiver approval of SDP. A copy of the MAA approval letter must accompany the submission of the final road/SWM construction plan original drawings, and/or site development plan original, or waiver petition application.

The waiver petition application must be accompanied by copies of a detailed plot plan, subdivision plat or site development plan (14 sets of the completed waiver application and plan exhibit if the subject property adjoins a County road; 18 sets for properties adjoining a State road). In instances where the waiver request concerns an approval extension or if an associated plan is in active processing, only 2 sets of plans are required along with 14 or 18 copies of the application form. Plans must be folded to a size no larger than 7-1/2" x 12". The pre-packaging of plans and supplemental reports by SRC agency will be permitted by DPZ provided that each package contains a cover letter which itemizes all plans, reports and documents included in the package.

Please be advised that all plan application submissions are ACCEPTED BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. All plan submission appointments must be scheduled with the Division of Land Development at (410) 313-2350.

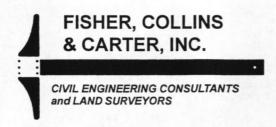

ATTACHMENT TO WAIVER PETITION MULLIN PROPERTY LOTS 1 AND 2 (#11975 FREDERICK ROAD)

The proposed Mullin Property subdivision contains approximately 6.217 acres and identifies 2 buildable lots utilizing the non-cluster design offered under the RR-DEO zoning designation. Although the total site is in excess of 6 acres the current regulations require the net lot area excluding pipestem area to be a minimum of 3 acres. The subtraction of the pipestem area reduces the net lot area to be less than 3 acres. The surrounding parcels of land in both recorded subdivisions and deeded parcels contain acreages in excess of 3 acres. The intent of the Mullin Property is to be compatible with the neighborhood but due to the subtraction of pipestem areas this intention requires the Mullin property to acquire 0.36 acres to compensate for this adjustment for pipestem subtraction.

The adjoining property identified as Tax Parcel 301 on Tax Map 16 contains 5.377 acres. The portion of this parcel that adjoins the Mullin Property contains floodplain, wetland, stream and their associated environmental buffers and blends with the wetland, stream and buffers located on the Mullin Property.

This requests asks for a waiver to Section 16.147 to allow the 0.36 acres of Tax Parcel 301 to be adjoined to the Mullin deeded parcel. Presently, the 5.377 acres contained in Tax Parcel 301 is greater than the minimum 3 acres required in the RR-DEO zoned district. The transfer of the 0.36 acres does not diminish or increase the present development potential of Tax Parcel 301. Because the transfer does not adversely effect the neighborhood continuity and does not nullify the intent of the Subdivision Regulations to artificially effect density or development potential for Tax Parcel 301, we feel this waiver is sound and will not be detrimental to public interests.

In addition, this request asks for a waiver to Section 16.120 (b) (4) (iii) (b) to allow environmental features to be located on buildable lots only in excess of 10 acres.

It is our opinion that locating environmental features, i.e. floodplain, wetland, stream and their buffers on the 2 non-cluster lots in the Mullin Property subdivision will not adversely effect the intent of the regulations. Both of the proposed house sites and their associated amenities are located an adequate horizontal distance and vertical elevation from these environmental features. An alternative to this lot design offered on the Mullin Property would be to offer a cluster 2 lot subdivision and place the environmental features on a non-buildable preservation parcel. Because there are only 2 lots proposed in the Mullin Property subdivision the maintenance of the non-buildable preservation parcel may fall short of continuing attention, trash removal and fall into disrepair. We feel that both the Mullin subdivision and neighboring properties would be best served if the ownership of the environmental features are located on the lots; each owner

will be more compelled and certainly responsible for the continuing quality of the environmental area and protection of the environment.
