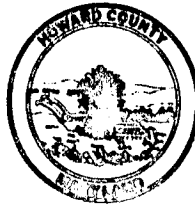

On August 31, 1983 I made an inspection at your property on Lawyers Hill Road in response to the above referenced building permit application. At that time I found a substandard sewage disposal system that was emptying into the storm drain at the front of the property.

Any addition to the existing house would aggravate an already unsanitary condition. Consequently, I regret to inform you that this office will deny your building permit application until such time as a satisfactory sewage disposal system is installed on the property.

If you should wish to attempt to upgrade your system, the first step is for you to contact this office to arrange for a percolation test to be conducted on your property. If that test proves satisfactory, then an appropriate sewage disposal system can be installed on the property.
