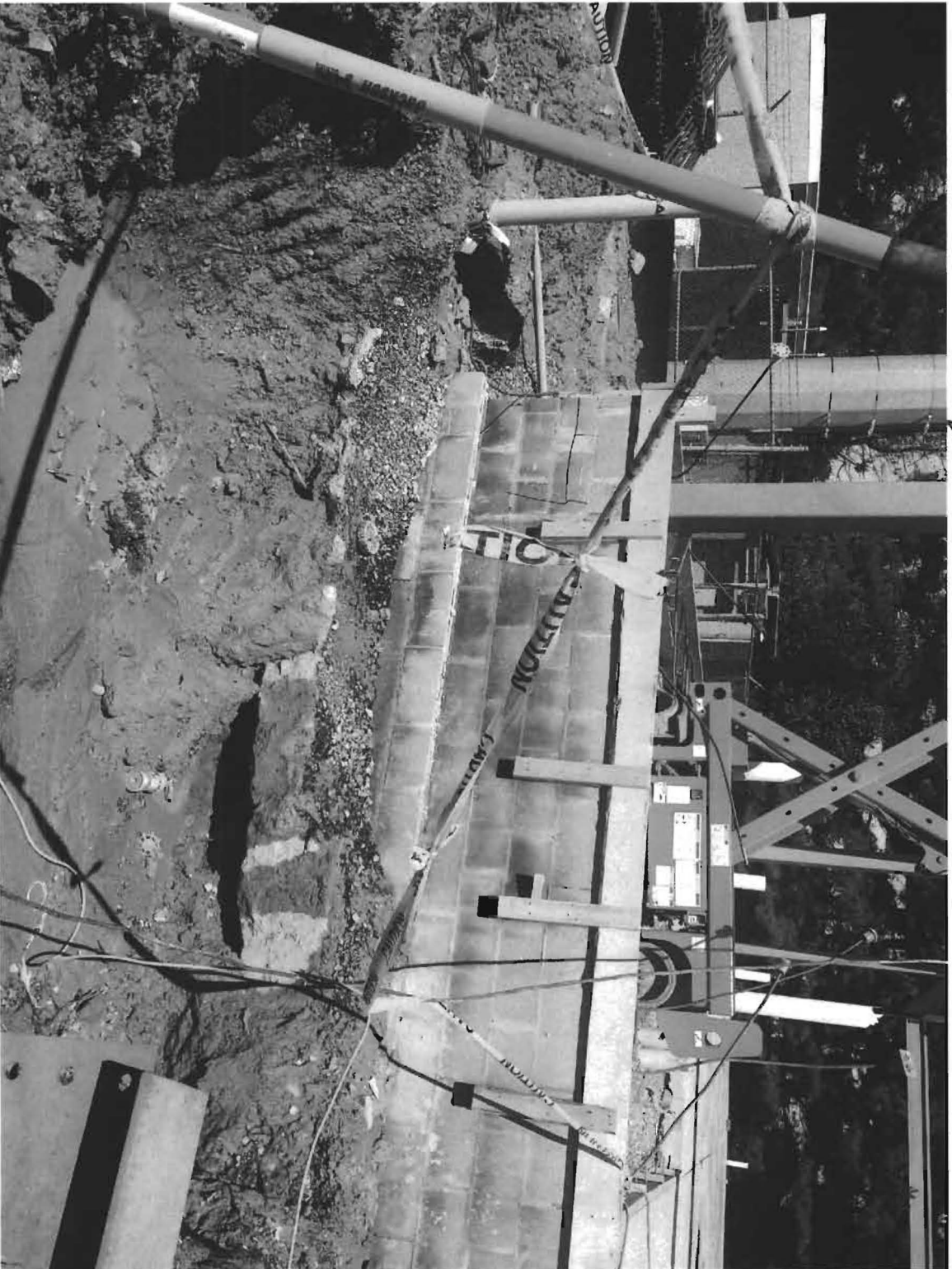

| 6/24/15 | <p>Site visit. Al showed me area where they discovered a potential tank. He said they dug up one wall and didn't find other walls. (hole is ~8' x <sup>12'</sup>8') Al said that they found a terra cotta pipe - possible connection? No sewage in tank. I told him it is okay for them to fill with stone + collapse tank. Area of digging is ~40' northeast of cell tower on property, off east side of new office building they are constructing. (SC)</p> |
