Dear Ms. Mielcarek:

This is a follow-up to the proposal dated October 28, 2011, submitted by Michael Davis with Howard County Bureau of Environmental Health regarding the above referenced sewer connection using BRF septic grant funds.

The proposal demonstrated compliance with the five statutory requirements under House Bill 57 (2011 session) to enable the above referenced property to connect to a wastewater treatment plant with ENR, using BRF Septic grant funds. The total BRF grant award for the proposed sewer connection (excluding CVI fee) should be based on the taxable income of the homeowner (per the FY 2012 program guidance) and not to exceed \$10,900 (lowest bid and county tap fee).

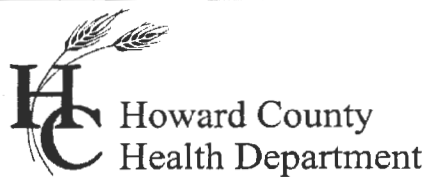

Jag/Kristin,

I think I have collected all necessary information for the proposal as discussed in yesterdays conference call, but have the following questions.

1. My proposal is to have the owner provide the 2010 tax return directly to CVI. How would CVI like to receive the document fax, email attachment, etc.? The homeowner is prepared to send it once this has been determined.
2. Exhibit C is the carbon copy style Howard County Connection Application that needs to be accompany the check. Is it possible to send the check addressed to the Director of Finance, Howard County to the property owner, so they can hand deliver it to the County? This will serve as notification to the owner that the check has been processed by the county. The check shall be issued to the County, so that should eliminate an concerns of misuse.
3. Will CVI contact the contractor about a payment schedule? Down payment with final payment to be paid within 30 days of completion?
4. If the proposal is adequate, what would be the timeframe for check issuance for the county fee and the down payment to the contractor?

**RE: ORDER TO CONNECT TO PUBLIC SEWER**  
9930 Windflower Dr.  
Tax Map 24, Parcel 961

Dear Mr. Strycharz,

The Howard County Health Department investigated your property on October 4th and observed a dry well that had collapsed exposing overflowing sewage. The collapse was likely caused by recent periods of heavy rainfall in the area. Based on the aforementioned information, the Health Department has determined that the failing dry well is considered a potential threat to health as described in Howard County Code Section 12.105, as would be any replacement on-site sewage disposal system.

Therefore, pursuant to provisions of Section 12.105 as amended by County Council Bill 32-202, you are hereby **ORDERED** to apply for the necessary permits to begin the process for connection to the public sewer system within 30 days from the date of this letter. Contact Mrs. Tammy Frank at (410) 313-3362 for assistance. Barring any unusual processing delays or extreme weather conditions, connection to the public sewer shall occur within 60 days of the date that an emergency sewer extension is completed.

**IN ADDITION**, to abate the public nuisance, and eliminate the immediate threat to public health, you are required to immediately pump the sewage from the dry well and have the area where sewage has flowed onto the soil surface treated with hydrated lime. Furthermore, you are responsible for maintaining the septic system to assure that the overflow of sewage onto the soil surface does not re-occur. This means that the septic tank and/or dry well may need to be emptied periodically by a licensed liquid waste hauler to prevent overflows until connection to public sewer has been completed. Upon connection to public sewer the septic tank and the dry well are both to be properly abandoned by pumping the remaining wastewater, removing or crushing the covers and, filling the voids with clean earth materials.

This decision may be appealed to the Board of Health. If you choose to appeal, you shall file a written request to the executive secretary of the Board of Health (at the address above) within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this order. Be advised that the Health Department has right-of-entry to conduct inspections of your septic system. Failure to comply with the full content of this order shall be grounds for enforcement action(s) as set forth in Section 12.110 of the Howard County Code.

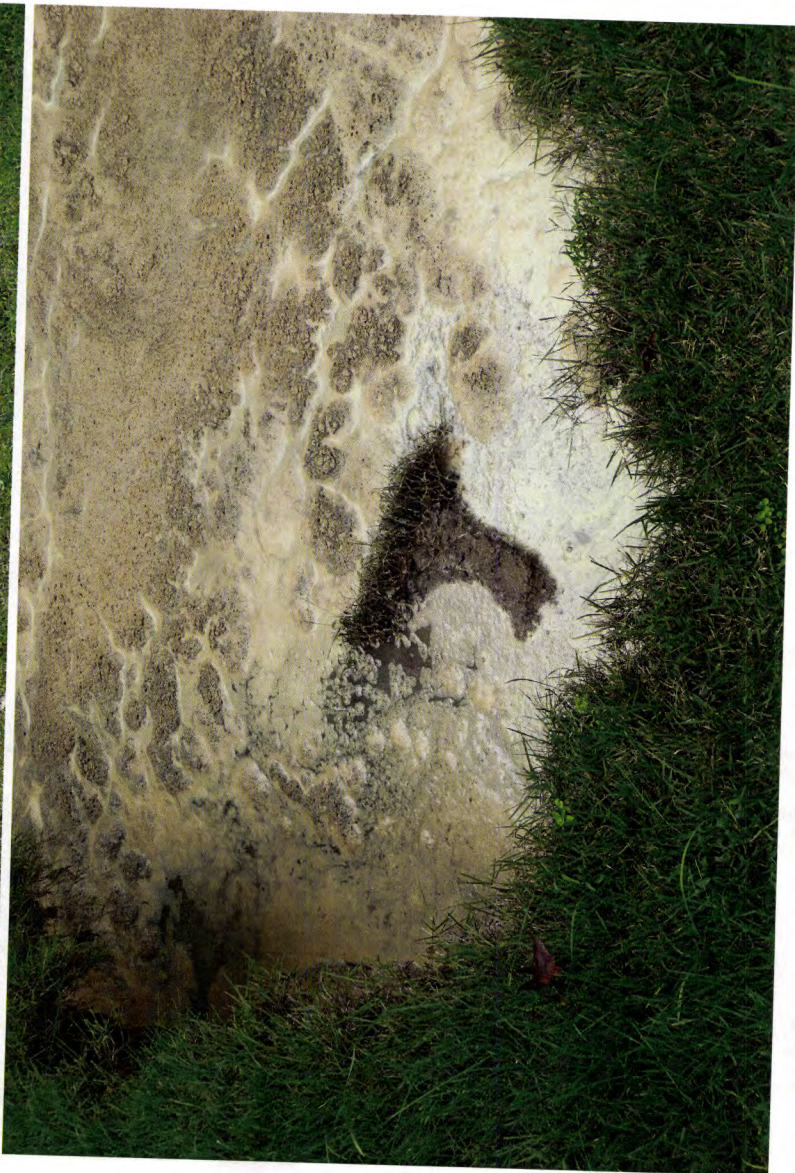

10/4/11	<p>~4pm. I met with Walter Strycharz on his property. I observed the septic tank location at the back of his house, and <del>some</del> about 25'-30' away, there was a large hole in the yard. Mr. Strycharz stated that he observed it that morning. The location is the same as the dry well. Standing downhill (downwind) the odor is that of sewage. The water in the hole is covered with soil particles. Some black staining is observed around the edge, and the pipe from the septic tank is observed.</p> <p>I advised <sup>(void)</sup> Mr. Strycharz that this is a 'nuisance' condition, a violation of code, and that he is required to pump the pit dry as soon as a pumper-hauler is available. Also the septic tank is to be pumped so that no discharge occurs until such time that connection to public sewer is completed.</p>

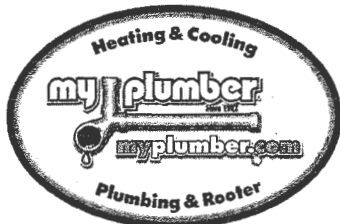

**Pipe:** Plumber will install 4" PVC pipe and fitting supported with stone where necessary.

**Cleanout:** One cleanout will be installed where your sewer meets the county sewer in the front yard, one where the new sewer connects to the house sewer and one in-between.

**Connection at house:** The new sewer will connect to the existing cast iron house sewer approximately 10 feet outside of the house and before the septic tank.

**Connection at street:** Plumber will install (3) seals at the sewer connection; (2) seals between your 4" pipe and the county 6" pipe and (1) seal over both pipes.

**Utilities:** Plumber will have utilities marked before work begins.

**Trench at completion:** Plumber will tamp any and all trenches to a level with grade condition.



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**Seeding:** NOT included in quote to be done at the owner's expense.

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**BAY RESTORATION (SEPTIC) FUND  
PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION GUIDANCE  
FOR ON-SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM (OSDS) UPGRADES USING BEST  
AVAILABLE TECHNOLOGY (BAT) FOR NITROGEN REMOVAL  
FY 2012**

### I. Prioritization

The Bay Restoration (Septic) Fund statute (Annotated Code of Maryland under 9-1605.2) requires that funding priority for BAT installations be "first given to failing septic systems and holding tanks in the Chesapeake and Atlantic Coastal Bays Critical Areas and then to failing septic systems that the Department (MDE) determines are a threat to public health or water quality ..." In addition, Senate Bill 554 approved in the 2009 legislative session, requires new and replacement septic systems serving property in the Critical Areas to include the best available technology for removing nitrogen (BAT) and House Bill 62 approved in the 2010 legislative session, requires MDE to assist homeowners with failing OSDS in critical areas from moneys in the Bay Restoration (Septic) Fund for 100% of the BAT cost during calendar years 2010, 2011 and 2012.

Consistent with the above, for FY 2012 grant funding, MDE requires "**grant recipients**" (local government, health department etc. who were awarded the BRF funds by the Board of Public Works) to prioritize application for financial assistance based on the following:

1. Failing OSDS or holding tanks in the Critical Areas<sup>1</sup>
2. Failing OSDS or holding tanks not in the Critical Areas
3. Non-failing OSDS in the Critical Areas including new BAT installation
4. Non-failing OSDS outside the Critical Areas

<sup>1</sup>*Critical Area Counties: Must ensure sufficient grant funds are available to comply with HB 62 (2010 session)*

### II. Income Based Grant Funding

To ensure an equitable distribution of the limited BRF grant funding for the upgrade of OSDS with BAT, MDE will require grant recipients to limit financial assistance to homeowners based on the following Income Based Criteria:

\* 1. Homeowner Occupied Primary Dwelling: Use 2010 Federal Income Tax Return as source document (This Income based criteria does not apply to any existing failing septic system in critical areas (residential or business); they are eligible for 100% BAT grant funding.)

2. All Other Applicants (Business, Non-Residential, Rental etc.) not in critical areas: Limit grant to 25% of BAT cost.

### **III. Eligible Cost for Bay Restoration (Septic) Fund Grant Funding**

Based on the above priority system, the BRF statute allows grant funding for:

- a. The cost attributable to upgrading an OSDS to BAT for nitrogen removal (**Note, most funding requests will fall under this category**); or
- b. The cost differential between a conventional OSDS and one that utilizes BAT for Nitrogen Removal; or
- c. The cost for repairing and replacing a failing OSDS with one that utilizes BAT for Nitrogen Removal (*Note, this option is available only to low-income owners, provided funds are available after addressing all BAT applications. For low-income eligibility criteria, visit MDE web site at:*  
<http://www.mde.state.md.us/programs/Water/BayRestorationFund/Pages/water/cbwrf/guidancedocs/financialhardship.aspx>; or
- d. The cost, up to the sum of the costs authorized under "b" of each individual system, of replacing multiple OSDS located in the same community with a new community system that is owned by a local government and that meets Enhanced Nutrient Removal Standards; or
- e. The cost up to the sum of the costs authorized under "c" of each individual system, to connect properties to an existing municipal wastewater facility achieving enhanced nutrient removal level treatment per HB 57 (2011 Session - effective 10/1/2011, if signed into law), provided ALL of the following conditions are met:

1. THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT OF THE ONSITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM IS DOCUMENTED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND CONFIRMED BY THE DEPARTMENT;

2. IT CAN BE DEMONSTRATED THAT:

- A. THE REPLACEMENT OF THE ONSITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM WITH SERVICE TO AN EXISTING MUNICIPAL WASTEWATER FACILITY THAT IS ACHIEVING ENHANCED NUTRIENT REMOVAL LEVEL TREATMENT IS MORE COST-EFFECTIVE FOR NITROGEN REMOVAL THAN UPGRADING THE INDIVIDUAL ONSITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM; OR

- B. THE INDIVIDUAL REPLACEMENT OF THE ONSITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM IS NOT FEASIBLE;

3. THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE COUNTY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND WATER AND SEWER MASTER PLAN;

4. THE ONSITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM WAS INSTALLED AS OF OCTOBER 1, 2008, AND THE PROPERTY THE SYSTEM SERVES IS LOCATED IN A PRIORITY FUNDING AREA, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 5-7B-02 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE; AND

5. THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT HAS ADOPTED A POLICY OR PROCEDURE THAT WILL GUARANTEE THAT ANY FUTURE CONNECTION TO AN EXISTING MUNICIPAL WASTEWATER FACILITY THAT IS FUNDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)(I)1E OF THIS SUBSECTION WILL MEET ALL OF THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER THIS SUBPARAGRAPH.

Grant eligibility includes capital cost of BAT plus the cost of 5-years of operations and maintenance performed by a certified service provider at a minimum of once per year or the minimum frequency recommended by the manufacturer.

***Prior MDE approval is needed for any requests under category "b" thru "e".***

#### **IV. MDE Approved BAT for Nitrogen Removal**

MDE currently has 15 approved BAT for nitrogen removal. See MDE website at:

Consistent with HB 347 (2011 Session), effective June 1, 2011, and every 2-years thereafter, MDE is required to provide on its website an Evaluation and Ranking of all best available nitrogen removal technologies for on-site sewage disposal systems. The evaluation will include for each BAT technology:

- Total Nitrogen Reduction
- Total cost including Operation, Maintenance and Electricity
- Cost per pound of Nitrogen Reduction

**As the BRF grant recipient, you will need to provide the above information to all BAT grant applicants within your County (i.e., homeowner/business that apply to you for BAT grant funding).**

To provide a simplified procurement process MDE undertook an Invitation for Bids from the four field-verified BAT technologies – Advantex, Hoot BNR, Norweco and Septitech. For Bay Restoration Fund BAT procurement purposes, MDE has selected the two lowest fixed unit price BAT by region. The 12-month (March 2010- 2011) CPI (+2.68%) adjusted cost/BAT for FY 2012, as follows:

#### **IV. Grant Recipient BAT Selection, Procurement and Price**

To allow flexibility, the grant recipients (local government, health department etc.) who were awarded the BRF funds by the Board of Public Works) may use the following procurement options:

1. Use either one of the two MDE procured fixed unit price BAT systems - The maximum grant eligible cost will be the fixed BAT unit price (above). No further local procurement action is needed.
2. Use another BAT system - The BAT may be any of the MDE approved BAT technologies and may be selected by considering other factors such as nitrogen removal efficiency, electrical cost, operations and maintenance cost. The maximum BRF grant eligible cost must be based on the "low bid" using local procurement process for that selected BAT. In some cases this will involve small purchase procurement using three price quotes/bids on the selected BAT.
3. Use one of four field verified BAT that is not one of the two MDE procured fixed unit price - The maximum BRF grant eligible cost is the "higher price" of the two MDE procured fixed unit price BAT systems, and any price difference being the homeowner's cost. This option may not require formal local procurement and is an alternative to option 2 above.

**Note: No BRF grant payment should be made directly to the homeowner; grant payments should be made out to the BAT vendor/installer.**

#### **V. Land Recordation & Future Operation & Maintenance**

The grant recipient must ensure that the BAT installation is recorded in the County land records and the homeowner/business has agreed to operate and maintain the system.
