

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

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

RE: Sewage overflow, pollution of ground surface at 1127 Taylor Park Road

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Inkman,

The Health Department received a call from a neighbor saying that sewage from your property was seeping into his yard. On January 9, 2019 at approximately 1 pm, I made a site visit to 1127 Taylor Park Road and saw a saturated area of the yard coming from a pipe outfall in the northwest corner of the property. Liquid had run off into the driveway of the neighbor at 1121 Taylor Park Road. I spoke with the property owner, Mr. Inkman, and he showed me that the septic tank had been modified to have a pipe drain from the upper part of the tank to the surface when the liquid level gets high in the septic tank.

Be advised that the condition of sewage effluent emerging onto the soil surface is a violation of the Code of Maryland (COMAR) 26.04.02.02(E): "A person may not dispose of sewage, body, or industrial wastes in any manner which may cause pollution of the ground surface, the waters of the State, or create a nuisance." This condition is also in violation of the Howard County Code 3.804(a)(1), as a sewage overflow is defined as a nuisance, [12.110(a)]. It is the property owner's responsibility to maintain the onsite sewage disposal system so that an overflow does not occur until a repair can be performed.

You are hereby ordered to immediately pump and haul the contents of the sewage disposal system and treat the contaminated soil with hydrated lime. You will be responsible for continuing to pump the contents of the system at a frequency that prevents sewage effluent from coming to the ground surface. In addition, you must cap off the pipe from the septic tank that allows septic effluent to surface.

Furthermore, you must apply for a septic repair permit within seven (7) days of receiving this notice and the repair must be completed within fourteen (14) days of receiving this notice. Failure to comply will result in the issuance of a civil citation(s). Under Howard County Code, paragraph 12.112, each day this violation is allowed to occur is considered a separate offense.

All requests are to be made in writing and directed to the Executive Secretary of the Board of Health at the above address.

LETTER OF ADVISEMENT

January 30, 2019

RE: Sewage overflow, pollution of ground surface at 1127 Taylor Park Road

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Inkman,

The Health Department issued a Notice of Violation on January 10, 2019 for sewage overflow and the pollution of the ground surface at 1127 Taylor Park Road. (see attached)

Several requirements of the Notice of Violation have been completed. The tank was pumped by Fogle's Septic Clean on January 18, 2019 and the Health Department received a copy of the receipt. The pipe from the septic tank that allowed sewage to drain to the ground surface has been capped and no additional sewage has leaked from it. Hydrated lime has been spread over the sewage in the yard and in the neighbor's driveway. Fogle's also completed percolation tests with the Health Department on January 25, 2019 and an area was found for a replacement septic system. You have paid for a percolation testing and site evaluation and Fogle's paid for a permit for a septic repair.

The septic system is still considered to be failing and has the potential to create a sewage overflow. You must continue to pump the tank and prevent sewage from overflowing to the ground surface until the repair installation has been completed. Be advised that the Health Department may issue a citation for any sewage observed on the ground surface and each day the violation is allowed to occur is considered a separate offense.




